IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA
To require that the District of Columbia Public Schools provide transportation to swing space locations that are greater than a 1/2 mile from the school's regular address.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
act may be cited as the "Swing Space Transportation Support Act of 2022".
Sec. 2. Swing Space Transportation Support.
(a) During the modernization of a District of Columbia Public Schools ("DCPS") school
facility, DCPS shall provide free round-trip transportation between the school's permanent
campus and the school's swing space campus in the following instances:
(1) If the school's swing space is located outside the normal boundaries of the
school, or
(2) If the school's swing space is located 1/2 mile or greater from the school's
permanent address.
