Project Goals:


- Preserve Existing Trees and Natural Elements





Existing Park Boundary



New Play Spot – Conceptual Birdseye View






New Play Spot – Conceptual Side Perspective






New Site Improvements – Site Grading and Planting



PROPOSED 8"x8" PRESSURE TREATED YELLOW PINE TIMBER BORDER, SECURE WITH REBAR CHAMFER EDGE 45' TYP. TOP CORNERS OF TOP FACE OF TIMBER MAXIMUM HEIGHT DIFFERENCE BETWEEN TOP OF TIMBER BORDER AND GRADE NOT TO EXCEED 18-INCHES CUT FOR 3-INCH DIAMETER WEEP HOLE TO ALLOW FOR DRAINAGE DISCHARGE PROPOSED PLANTINGS FOR 3-FT WDE BUFFER AREA, REFER TO PLANTING ENGINEERED WOOD FIBER (EWF) 12-INCH THICK SECTION, TYP. 


