

CRESTWOOD TRIANGLE PARK

PROJECT UPDATE: NOVEMBER 2023

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The Crestwood Triangle Park renovation and improvements include:

- Preserve Existing Trees and Natural Elements
- Preserve Open Space for gathering and events
- Nature-Inspired Play Spot
- Improve the grass in the park (power-tilled overseeding per UFD)
- New Tree Plantings
- ADA access
- New Site Furnishings and Signage

PROJECT TIMELINE:

- Outreach and Survey: 2020
- Survey Results: 2021
- Design Begins: 2022
- Final Design: February 2023
- Permits: Spring-Summer 2023
- Construction Begins: Fall 2023
- Construction Complete: Winter/Spring 2024

WHAT HAPPENED LAST MONTH:

- Aeration and seeding of the existing lawn in the park
- Construction began in earnest
- Mobilization included fencing with sediment and erosion control around the play area
- Tree protection fencing will be installed around the trees adjacent to the park on Argyle Terrace
- Fencing was installed around the lawn area of the park. This part of the park was seeded and the fence will protect the new grass as it germinates.
- DDOT Signs for No Parking adjacent to the park for the contractors will be installed on Argyle Terrace
- Relocation of the existing honoring tree
- New trees were installed in the park
- Plantings were installed around the perimeter of the play area
- Site excavation began
- Retaining Walls have started
- Bike Racks are installed

WHAT TO EXPECT IN THE COMING MONTH:

- Perimeter drains will be installed in the play area
- Rough grading and the base gravel will be installed in the play area
- Park bench and bulletin board will be installed
- ADA accessible entrance surface will be installed
- Climbable play equipment will be delivered and installed
- Play area benches will be installed
- Timber Walls will be completed



The new bike racks have been placed. The timber edging is being installed and some rough grading of the site along with perimeter plantings has begun.



These park perimeter trees have been planted. They are American Hollies (Ilex opaca).
