## Road Closure/Traffic Detour from the 6700-6900 Blocks of Piney Branch Road, NW, 600 Block of Aspen Street, NW, and 700-800 Blocks of Venable Place, NW for DC PLUG Feeder 15009 Begins March 18-30, 2024.

(WASHINGTON, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) advises stakeholders to expect delays due to upcoming road closures/traffic detours for milling and paving. All residents will keep access to their homes. Please adhere to all NO Parking signs.

- **On March 18-30, 2024-Milling Paving, in the 6700 to 6900 blocks of Piney Branch Road, NW between Butternut Street, and Whittier Street, NW, Monday – Friday 9:30 am to 3:30 pm**
- **Piney Branch Rd – Whittier to Aspen (Southbound) – Traffic detoured through Georgia Avenue, NW**
- **Piney Branch Rd – Whittier to Aspen (Northbound) – Traffic detoured through Georgia Avenue, NW**
- **Piney Branch Rd – Butternut to Aspen (Southbound) – Traffic detoured through 8th Street, NW**

The road closure is estimated to last **2 weeks** to complete the installation of conduits (weather permitting). The milling and paving are necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative's Feeder 15009 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.
