## Temporary Long Term Lane Closures Along Eastbound Kennedy Street N.W. From 16<sup>th</sup> Street N.W. to 14<sup>th</sup> Street N.W. and from 13<sup>th</sup> Street N.W. and Georgia Avenue N.W. Starting Friday, March 22, 2024

(WASHINGTON, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will implement temporary long term lane closures along the eastbound lane of Kennedy Street, NW, between 16th Street NW and 14th Street NW, as well as between 13<sup>th</sup> Street NW and Georgia Avenue NW (see maps below), **starting on Friday, March 22, 2024**, for the Reconstruction of Kennedy Street NW project, weather permitting. Traffic will be advised to follow detour signs and roadway signs to navigate around the construction zone.

The contractor is authorized to work Monday through Friday, (daytime) from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. The contractor may work Saturdays (daytime) with prior DDOT approval.

Traffic controls, including signage, will be in place to guide motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians safely through the work zone. All users of the roadway are advised to stay alert and be observant of signage and work zones while traveling in this area. Motorists are urged to use caution as they travel in these areas, to anticipate moderate delays, and to be mindful of construction personnel.
