Re: Georgia Avenue & Alaska Avenue NW Safety Improvement Plan

Dear Commissioner:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCMR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

- **Georgia Avenue & Alaska Avenue NW Safety Improvement Plan**

As part of our ongoing efforts to enhance road safety and improve traffic flow in our community, DDOT will be implementing several changes, including updates to parking signs, installation of new crosswalk pavement markings and the addition of new left turn lanes at the intersection of Georgia Avenue & Alaska Avenue/Kalmia Road NW. A few parking spaces along Georgia Avenue will be removed to accommodate this proposed design.

New parking signs will be installed to clarify parking regulations and ensure better compliance with parking restrictions in the vicinity of the intersection. New crosswalk pavement markings will be installed to enhance pedestrian safety. The proposed left turn lanes will provide motorists with designated spaces to safely execute left turns, reducing delays and improving overall intersection efficiency.

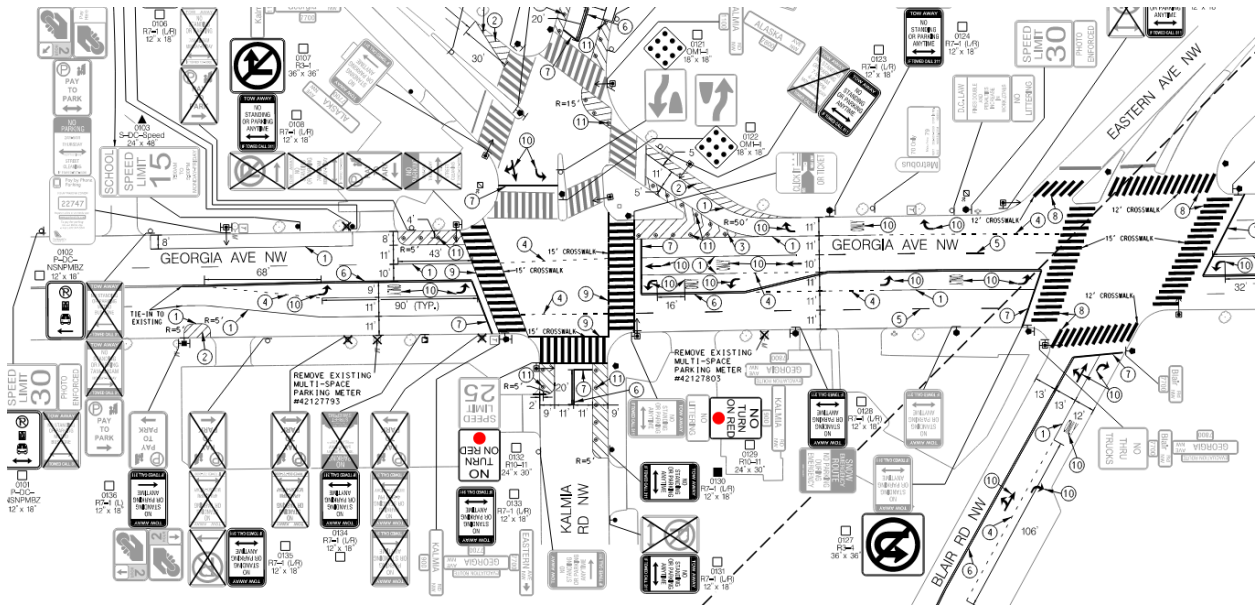


Figure 1: Proposed operations at Georgia Avenue & Alaska Avenue/Kalmia Road NW

Figure 1 illustrates the proposed operations at Georgia Avenue & Alaska Avenue/Kalmia Road NW.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing Wednesday, May 1, 2024 (thirty business days after the date of this notice), with the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), Project Delivery Administration at 250 M Street, SE, Washington, D.C. 20003. DDOT will review and evaluate comments and anticipates initiating implementation of the above-mentioned modifications starting at the end of the thirty business days, pending weather conditions.

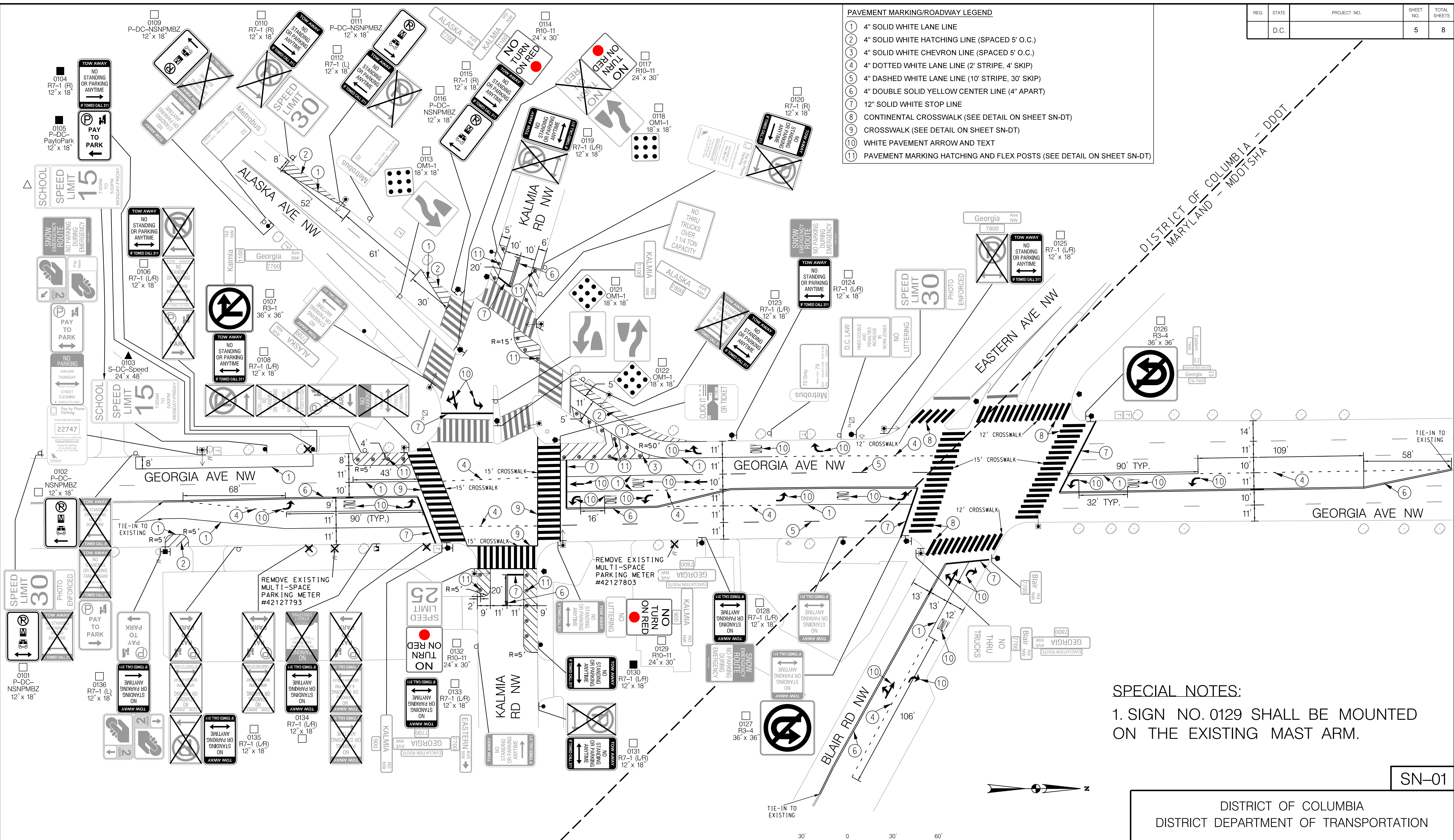

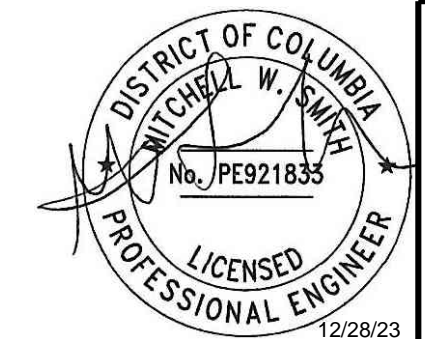
